When a patient wants a contact lenses exam, a 'fitting' is required.

There is an additional charge for this time which is called a 'fitting fee'. This fee is for the additional exam time and the trial contacts that you will be 'fitted' with. It also includes follow-up appointments as needed until you have been 'fitted' satisfactorily.

The charge for a 'contact fitting fee' is between \$40 and \$50 depending on the lens type. This charge is to be paid at the time of service.

Note: If your vision insurance includes contact lens coverage, your fitting charge *may* be included in the contact lens allowance, depending on the insurance benefit schedule.
